MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

NORFOLK SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

and

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES

WHEREAS, the parties desire to transfer the Brandt Material Handling Truck position and the Log Loader position from the Northern Region Vehicle Operator Roster to the Northern Region Class I Machine Operator;

IT IS AGREED, the July 1, 1986 NW-WAB Agreement, as amended, is revised as follows:

- 1. Rule 2 (h) Track Sub-department (B) 3 and (E) are revised to remove the Brandt Truck and the Log-loader from the list of equipment contained under Vehicle Operator and add them to the list of machine types that are included in the Class I Machine Operator Roster.
- 2. The Brandt Material Handling Truck and the Log Loader are separate particular types of Class I machines for which employees must qualify in accordance with Rule 11. The current occupants of the Brandt Material Handling Truck and the Log Loader positions, listed on Attachment A, will be deemed to be qualified on their respective Brandt Material Handling Truck or Log Loader, regardless of whether they currently possess Class I Machine Operator seniority. Those current occupants who do not already possess Class I Machine Operator seniority will not establish a Class I Machine Operator seniority date as a result of this recognition of their qualification on the respective machine.
- 3. Employees who are listed on the Vehicle Operator roster, with a Vehicle Operator seniority date that is prior to the date of this Agreement, will be grandfathered so as to have preferential rights to such respective position regardless of their relative standing on the Class I Machine Operator Roster. Accordingly, a grandfathered employee cannot be displaced from a Brandt Material Handling Truck or a Log Loader position by an employee who is not grandfathered, regardless of their relative standing on the Class I Machine Operator roster. Grandfathered employees will be considered ahead of Class I Machine Operators in filling temporary positions in accordance with Rule 13.

4. Subsequent to the date of this Agreement, the occupants of the Brandt Material Handling Trucks and the Log Loader positions will be paid at the Class I Machine Operator rate of pay. Any subsequent bulletining of new positions or vacancies for the Brandt Material Handling Trucks and the Log Loaders will be as Class I Machine Operator positions. However, if any grandfathered employees submit a bid on the position the assignment of the Log Loader or Brandt Material Handling Truck position will be made on the basis of the relative standing of such grandfathered applicants on the Vehicle Operator roster. The grandfathered employee awarded the position will be subject to the qualification requirements of Rule 11 (b) if such employee has not previously qualified. Any awarding of a Brandt Material Handling Truck or Log Loader position when no grandfathered employees submit a bid, or any exercise of a displacement right to a Brandt Material Handling Truck or Log Loader position not occupied by a grandfathered employee, will be based on Class I Machine Operator seniority and subsequently satisfying the qualification requirements of Rule 11 (b).
